

ASSOCIATE DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

Associate in Arts for Transfer (AA-T) or Associate in Science for Transfer (AS-T)

The Student Transfer Achievement Reform Act (Senate Bill 1440, now codified in California Education code sections 66746-66749) guarantees admission to a California State University (CSU) campus for any community college student who completes an "associate degree for transfer." The Associate in Arts for Transfer (AA-T) or the Associate in Science for Transfer (AS-T) is intended for students who plan to complete a bachelor's degree in a similar major at a CSU campus.

Students completing these degrees (AA-T or AS-T) are guaranteed admission to the CSU system, but not to a particular campus or major. Students transferring to a CSU campus that does accept the AA-T or AS-T will be required to complete no more than 60 units after transfer to earn a bachelor's degree (unless the major is a designated "high-unit" major). This degree may not be the best option for students intending to transfer to a particular CSU campus or to university or college that is not part of the CSU system. Students should consult with a counselor for more information on university admission and transfer requirements.

The following Associate Degree for Transfer requirements must be completed to earn the AA-T or AS-T degree.

- 60 CSU-transferable semester units.
- The California State University General Education-Breadth (CSU GE-Breadth) pattern; **or** the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) pattern.
- Earn a minimum of 18 semester units in the major or area of emphasis as determined by the community college district.
- Obtainment of a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.0.
- Earn a grade of C or better in all courses required for the major or area of emphasis.
- For the Associate Degree for Transfer, students must meet the residency requirement of 12 units completed at MPC but do not need 6 units of residency within the major as with general associate degrees.
