

ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP)

Students may earn credit for College Board Advanced Placement (AP) exams with scores of 3, 4, or 5. AP may be used to meet Cal-GETC and AA/AS general education requirements.

For credit to be applied, students must have the College Board send their official AP exam results to the Monterey Peninsula College Admissions and Records Office; only official, sealed copies will be accepted.

Students planning to use AP credit for transfer should check with the transfer institution regarding its AP credit policies.
