Students may earn credit for International Baccalaureate (IB) exams with scores as noted in the charts. IB credit may be used to meet IGETC,

CSU GE, and AA/AS general education requirements. For credit to be applied, students must have the International Baccalaureate Organization send their official IB exam results to the Monterey Peninsula College Admissions and Records Office; only official, sealed copies will be accepted.

## **IB: IGETC Credit 2024-2025**

Students who have earned credit from an IB exam should not take a comparable college course because transfer credit will not be granted for both.

College courses taken before or after attending UC may duplicate AP, IB, and/or A-Level examinations. Additionally, exams may duplicate each other (for example, an AP or IB exam in the same subject area). If the student does duplicate an exam with another of the same subject content and/or with a college course, UC will award credit only once.
