

EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN 1: BASIC TRAINING, NONCREDIT CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION

The Emergency Medical Technician 1: Basic Training Certificate of Completion is designed to meet the Department of Transportation, National Registry of EMTs, and State of California requirements for certification as an EMT-Basic (Ambulance) crew member. The Basic Training certificate prepares students to care for patients in the prehospital setting.

- Define the roles, responsibilities, and limitations of the Emergency Medical Technician.
- Assess and apply emergency treatment procedures for medical, trauma, and environmental patients in the clinical setting.
