HUMA 10 - Exploration of Values in Living (3 units)

Letter Grade (LG) or Pass/No Pass (P/NP) • Total hours: 51 hours lecture

This course explores the complexities of the human experience from antiquity through the modern era. Emphasis is placed on self-knowledge, critical thinking, and responsible value choices through the study of art, science and technology, philosophy, religion, mythology, and ethics. Portions of instruction may be offered online; may also be offered fully online.

HUMA 30 - Humanities in Multicultural America (3 units)

Letter Grade (LG) or Pass/No Pass (P/NP) • Total hours: 51 hours lecture

This course examines underlying philosophies and worldviews of Native Americans, European Americans, African Americans, and Asian Americans, as expressed in literature, fine arts, music, dance, drama, and architecture, using three major humanities themes: freedom, love, and nature. Portions of instruction may be offered online; may also be offered fully online.

HUMA 40 - Introduction to Feminist Theory (3 units)

Letter Grade (LG) or Pass/No Pass (P/NP) • Total hours: 51 hours lecture

This course surveys the broad field of intersectional feminist study known as feminist theory, emphasizing textual analysis and argumentative reasoning and writing and introducing students to primary traditions in critical theory and major issues of feminist concern. Offered as GWOS 40, HUMA 40, and PHIL 40; credit may be earned only once. Portions of instruction may be offered online; may also be offered fully online.
