The Monterey Peninsula College Theatre Arts department offers a balanced approach to both the academic study and practical application of the knowledge, skills, and techniques essential to the theatrical experience. The AA-T in Theatre Arts offers a focus in Performance Training and Technical Theatre. Students will be prepared to transfer seamlessly into the CSU system to pursue a baccalaureate degree in Theatre Arts or related major. Students must complete the Associate Degree for Transfer requirements to earn the AA-T degree.
